Erin Cottos to Visit Sunday, 10/20

Our resident missionary, Erin Cottos will be with us in a little over two weeks to share what God has been doing in her life this past year. Be sure to put this on your calendar for Sunday, October 20th.

For those of you who haven't met Erin, she has been a parishioner here at St. Mark's since 2004. In 2009, God called her into the mission field, specifically to the country of Haiti. He expanded her call to include time in Guatemala and Kenya, but her heart belongs to the people of Haiti. As a pediatric physical therapist, Erin uses her love of children and knowledge of healing to make a difference in the lives of children where often there is little hope, especially for those with a disability.

We will take up an offering to help support Erin in the work that God has called her to do in His Kingdom.


